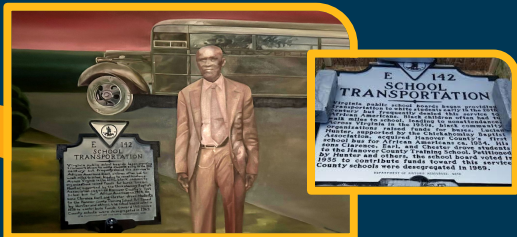

Fought to limit development and preserve Black history. #SaveBrownGrove, now a designated Historic Rural District.
